Consistency is key for our students and parents to have a successful online learning experience. Check each of the green boxes below to ensure you're Canvas Modules are set for the week.



## Setup Online Lessons for the Week

If you include the following tasks when establishing your Canvas content for the week, it will provide little confusion for your student and parents with their online learning experience.

- Add to Modules Only.** Whether you're adding Pages, Discussions, Assignments or Quizzes, all items should exist in a Module so students go to one spot for their content of the week.
- Title each Module** with weeks range of dates. This way students and parents can easily find the module of focus for the week.
- Sort your Modules** so that the current module has been moved to the top of the page. Less scrolling aids in a better online learning experience
- Add Due Dates (not shown)** – Please be sure Assignment, Discussions, & quizzes have due dates tied to them. This will also populate the students' calendars with those important items.
